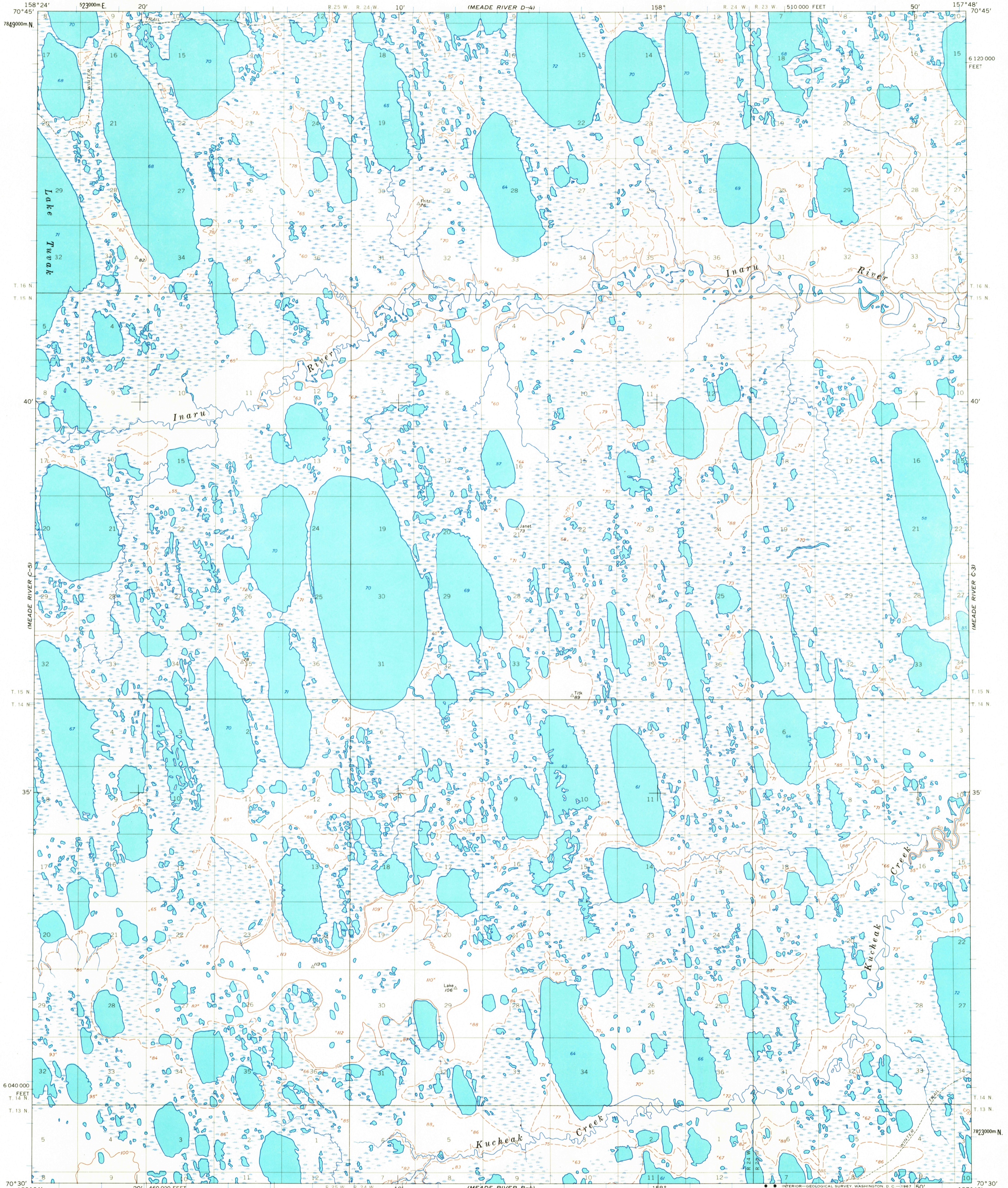

Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management, Folio U-5, Umiat Meridian.
Entire area lies within Naval Petroleum Reserve No. 4.
Lake elevations are unchecked.
