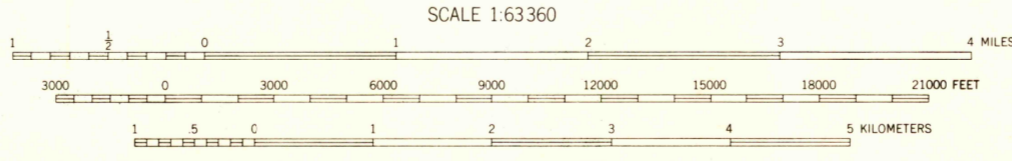
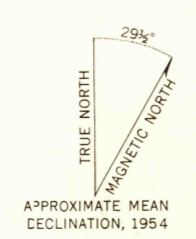
MT. FAIRWEATHER (A-2) QUADRANGLE
