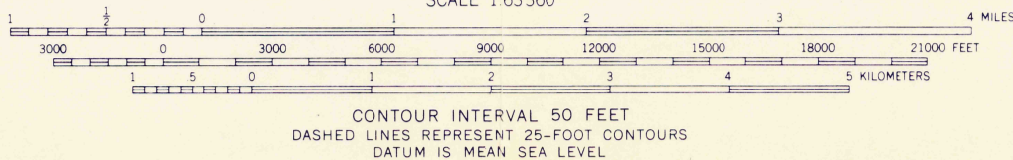
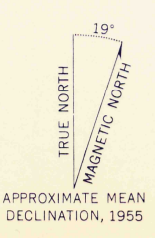
NOATAK (C-3) QUADRANGLE
