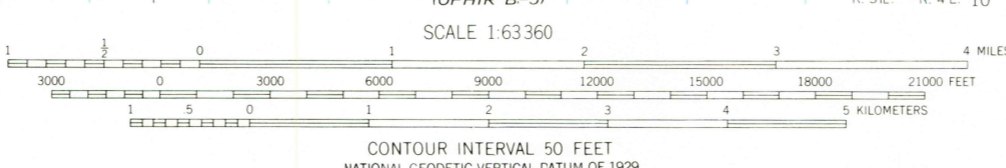
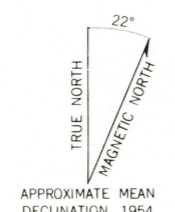

10,000-foot grids ticks based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 6, 1927 North American Datum  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 76 meters north and 125 meters east  
Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management  
Folio K-18, Kateel River Meridian  
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map  
Federal reservation boundaries established by the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act, PL 96-487, Dec. 2, 1980 are shown as compiled by the administering agencies
