Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge consists of all the public land in the coastal waters and adjacent seas of Alaska consisting of islands, islets, rocks, reefs, capes and spires, as well as a designated mainland areas
