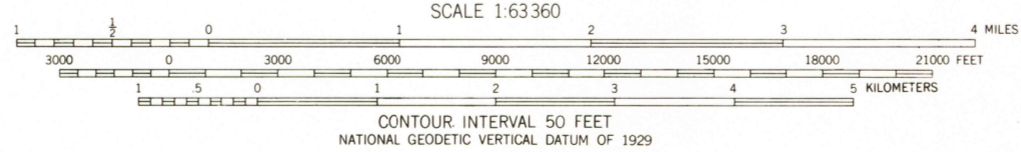
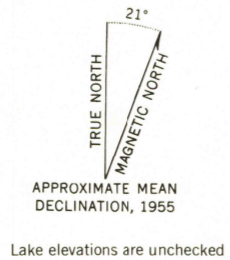

predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Folios K-3 and K-7, Kateel River Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 70 meters north and 125 meters east
