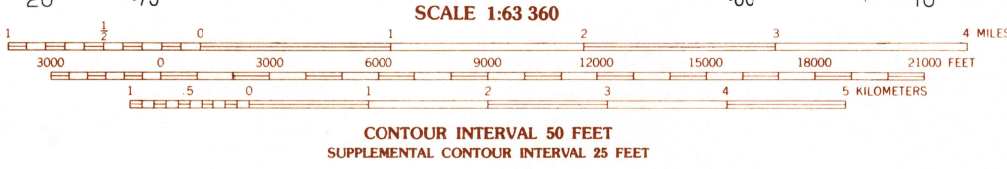

as compiled by the administering agencies.  
All streams and lakes are perennial.  
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low  
relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs.
