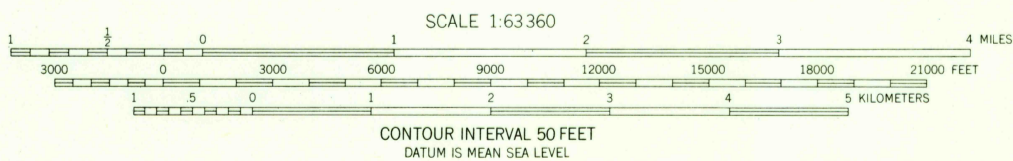
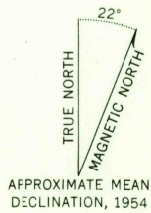


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Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods 1957. Aerial photographs taken 1953, field annotated 1954. Map not field checked

Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs



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
