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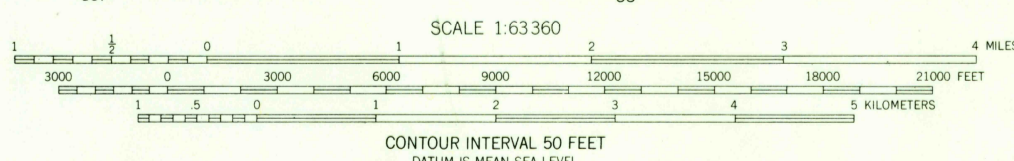

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 4, shown in blue

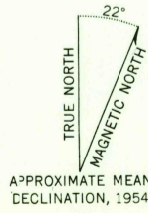
