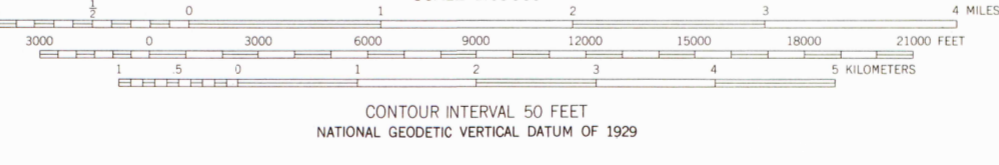
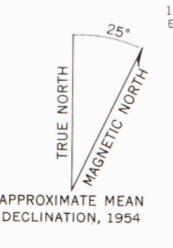

Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management Folio S-13, Seward Meridian.
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas, usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs.
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 67 meters north and 121 meters east.
