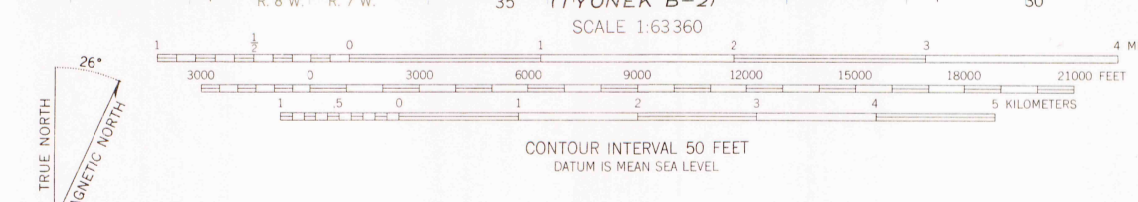

predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management
Files S-2, and S-13, Seward Meridian
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief as interpreted from aerial photographs
