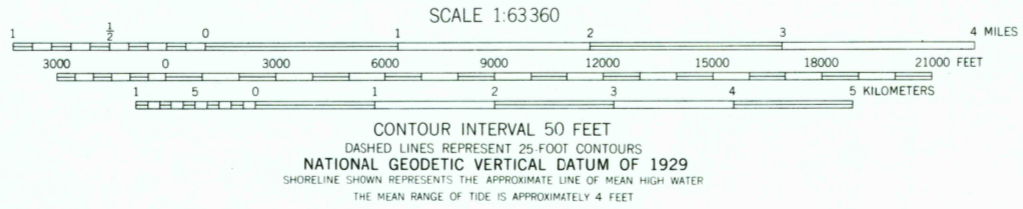

Universal Transverse Mercator projection, 1927 North American datum  
10,000-foot grid based on Alaska coordinate system, zone 7  
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,  
zone 4, shown in blue.  
Land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations  
predetermined by the Bureau of Land Management  
Folio K-17, Kateel River Meridian  
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move  
the projection lines 81 meters north and 128 meters east  
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,  
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of  
the National or State reservations shown on this map

The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge consists of  
all public lands in the coastal waters and adjacent seas of  
Alaska consisting of islands, islets, rocks, reefs, capes and spires
