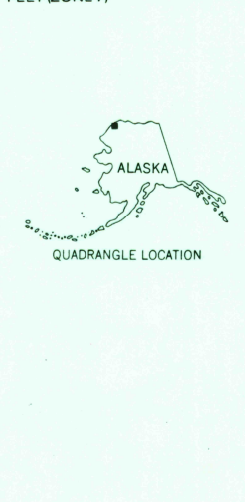

Gray land lines represent unsurveyed and unmarked locations predetermined
by the Bureau of Land Management, Folio U-5, Umat Meridian
Lake elevations are unchecked
Swamps, as portrayed, indicate only the wetter areas,
usually of low relief, as interpreted from aerial photographs
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
the projection lines 59 meters north and 127 meters east
