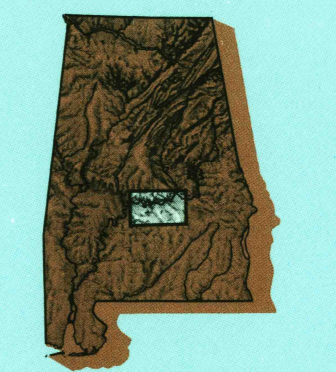


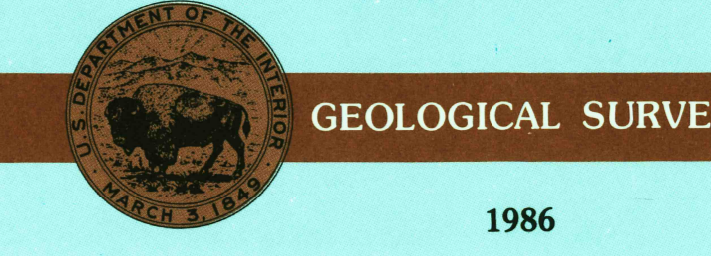
# Montgomery ALABAMA
