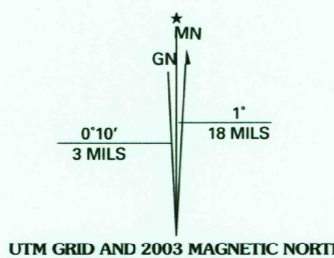

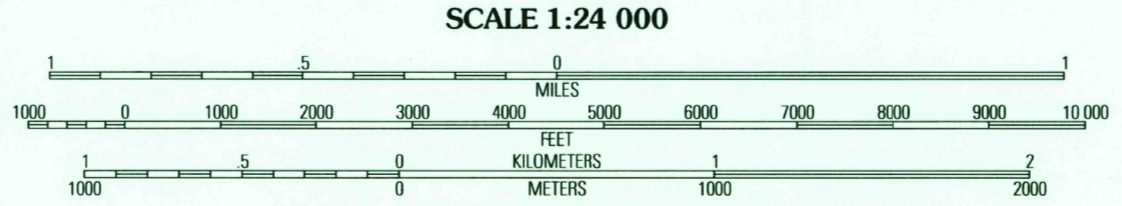
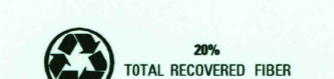

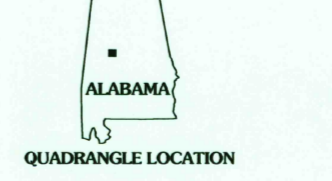


UTM GRID AND 2003 MAGNETIC NORTH DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET
