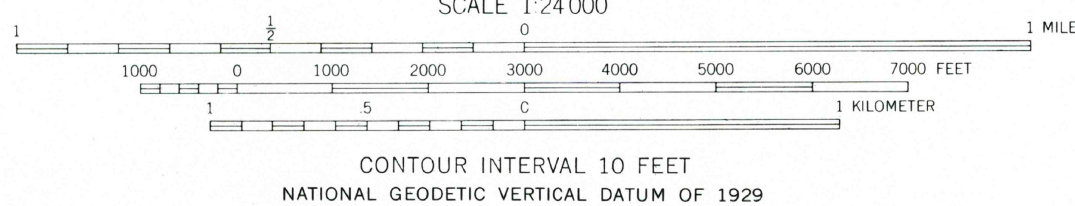
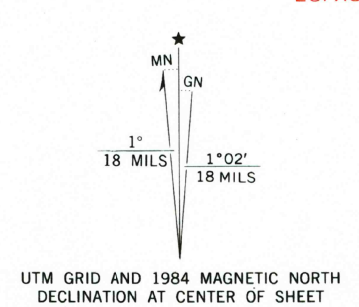

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 13 meters south and 7 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
