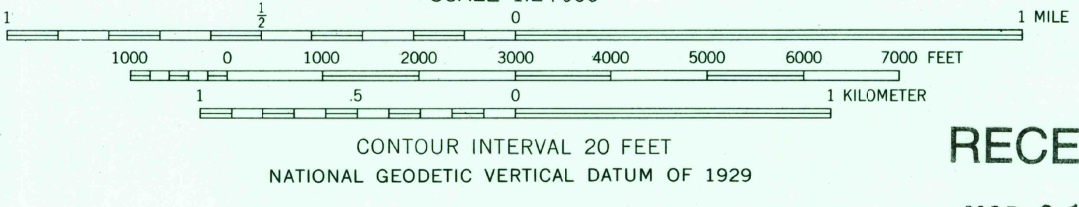
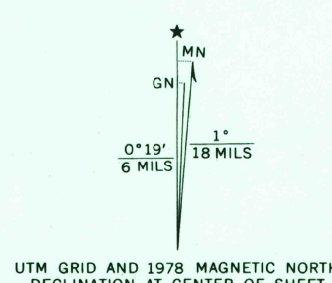
10,000-foot grids based on Alabama coordinate system,
