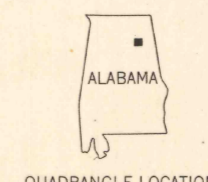
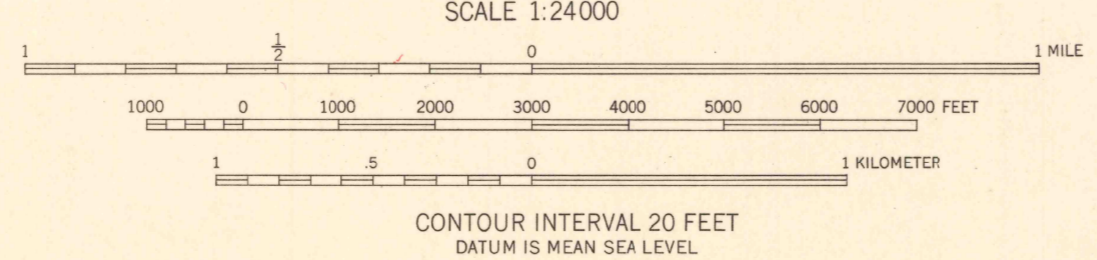

DECLINATION, 1947



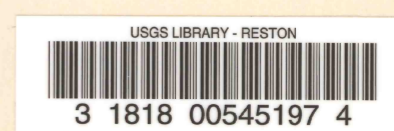
