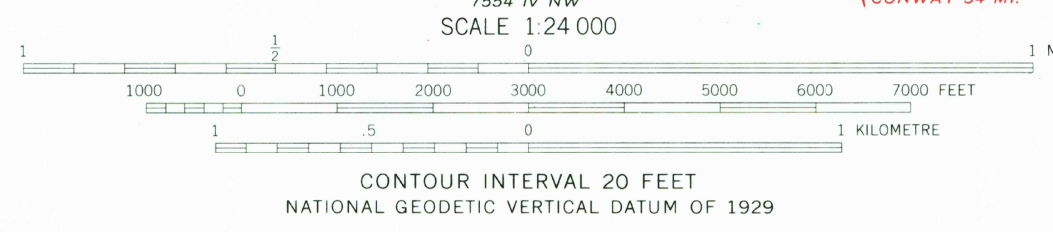
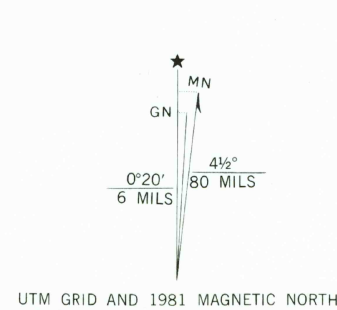

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Arkansas coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue. 1927 North American datum
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters south and 14 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
