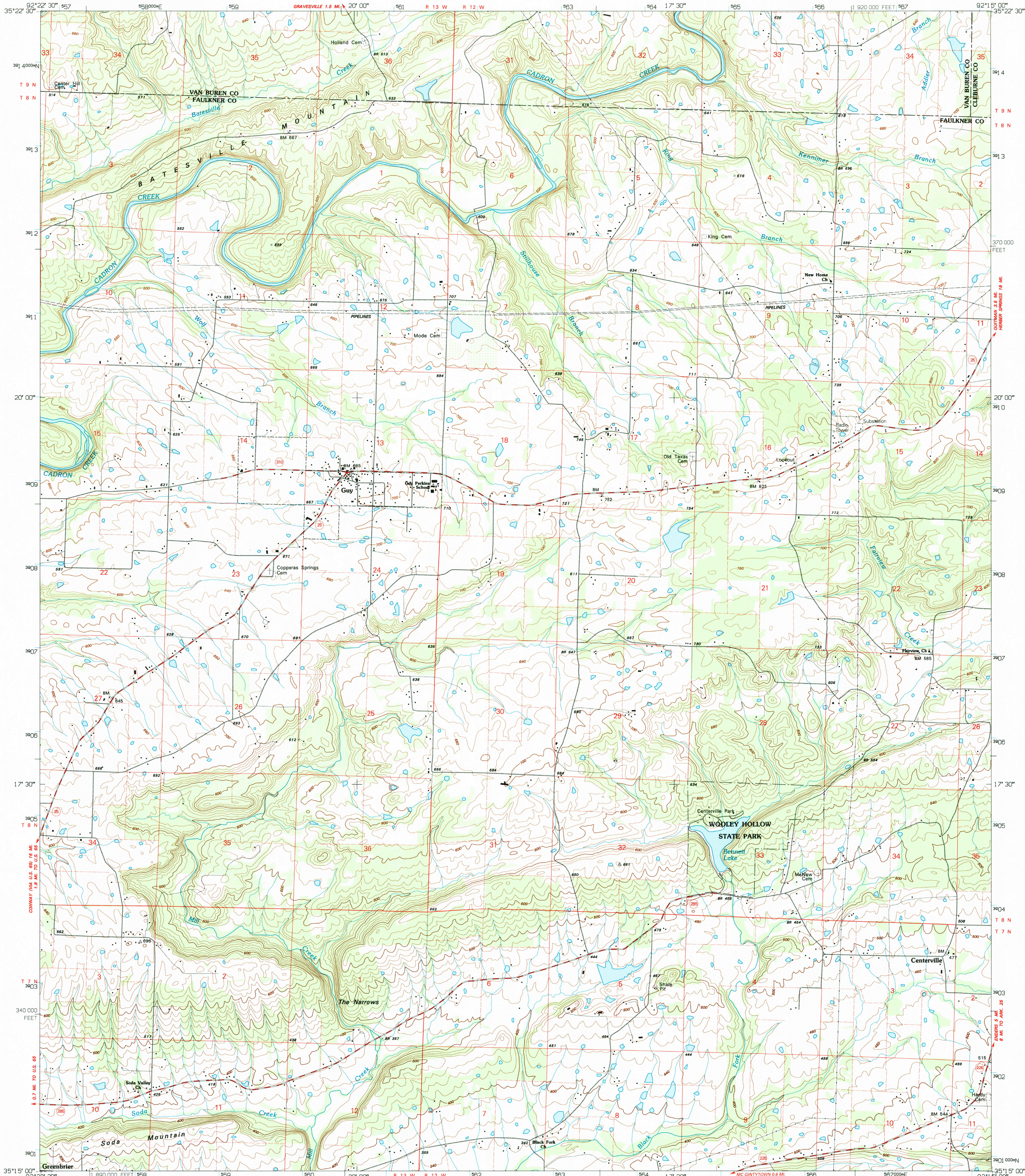


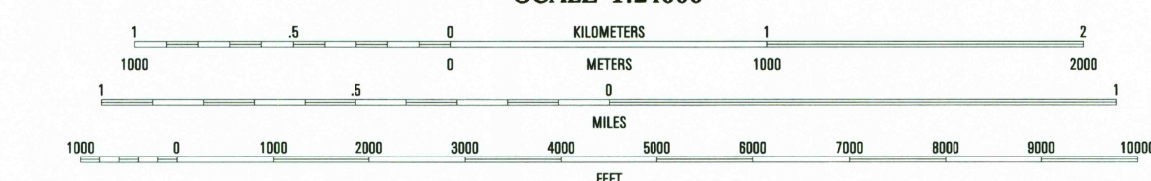

DECLINATION AT CENTER OF SHEET

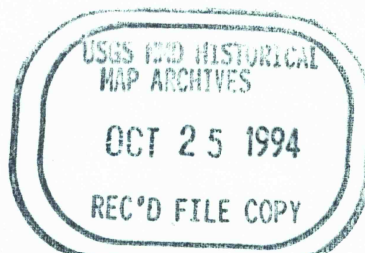
