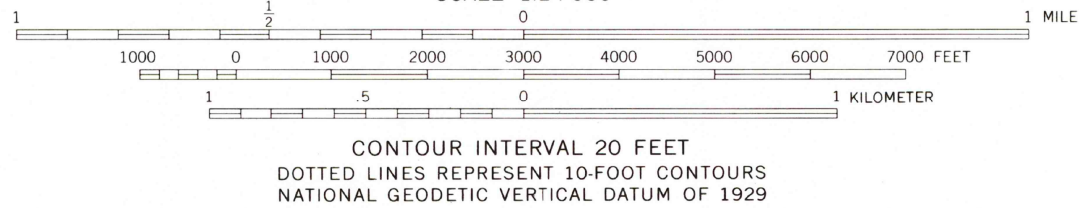
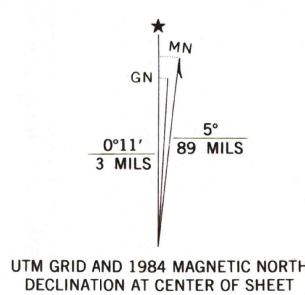
10,000-foot grids based on Arkansas coordinate system, north and south zones

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue

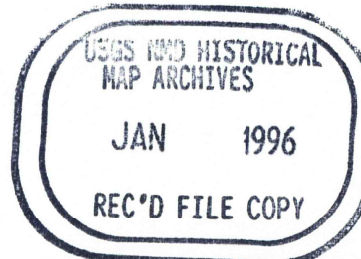
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 7 meters south and 15 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
