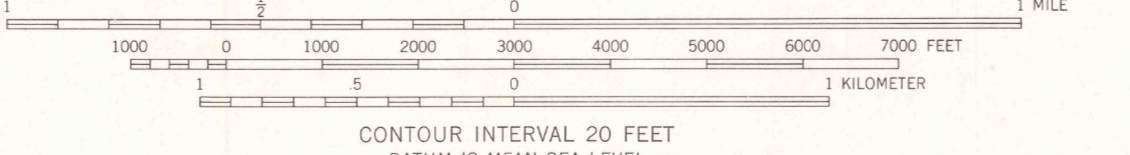
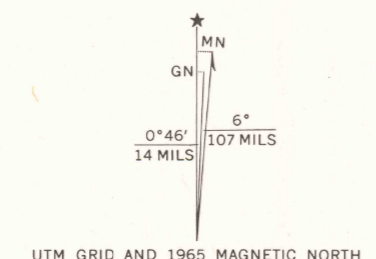
10,000-foot grid based on Arkansas coordinate system, north zone
