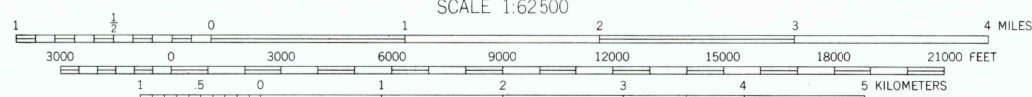

landmark buildings are shown

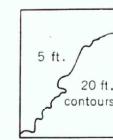
UTM GRID AND 1958 MAGNETIC NORTH
