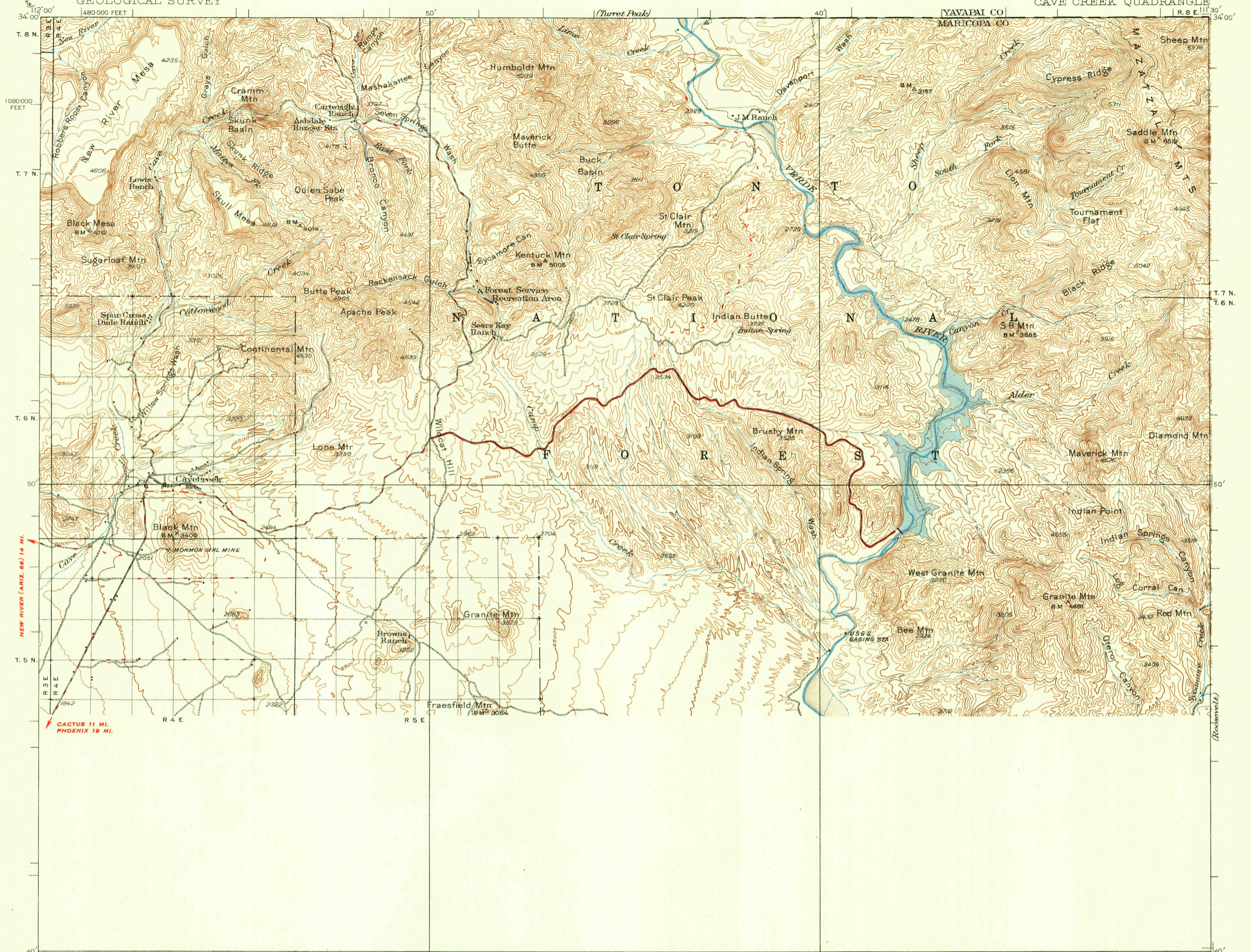

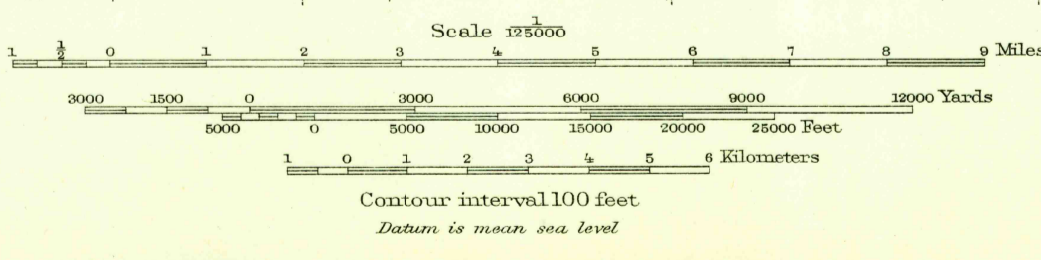
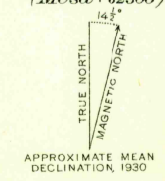


DIAGRAM OF TOWNSHIP
