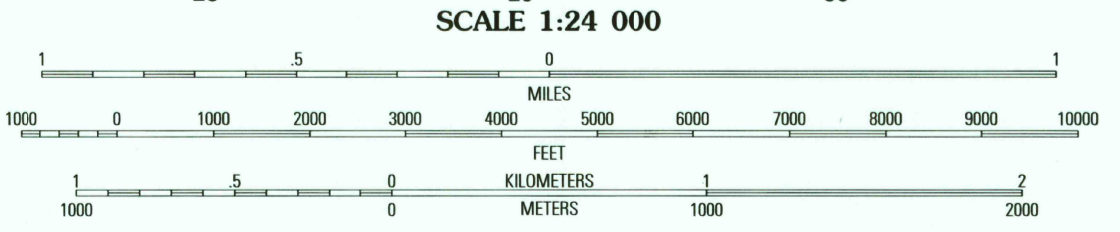
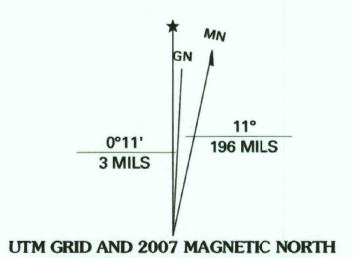

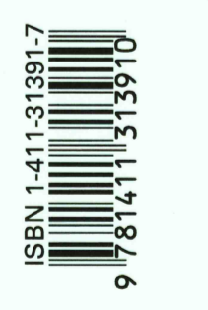


ADJOINING 7.5' QUADRANGLES table with grid and quadrant numbers 1-8.
