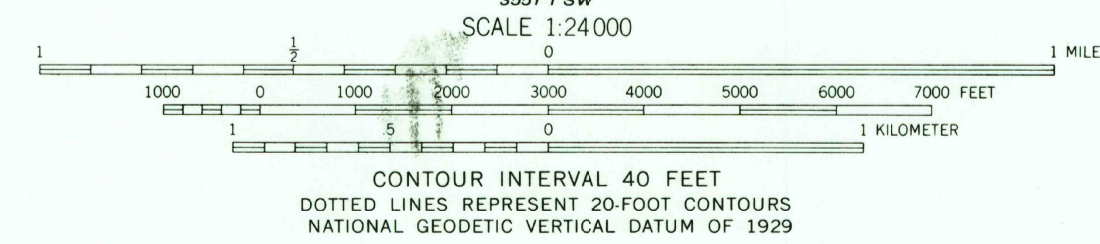
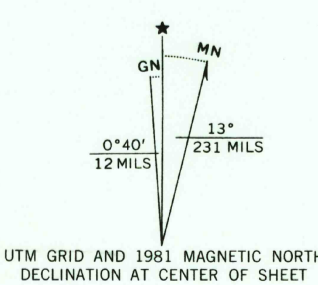

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 1 meter south and 66 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
