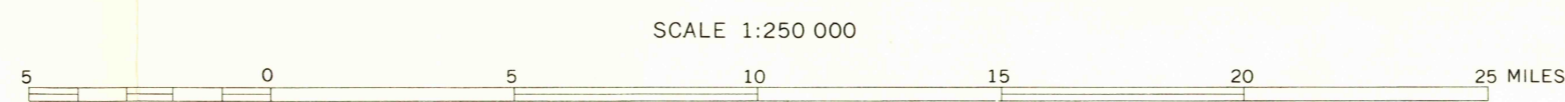

ZONE 12, SHOWN IN BLUE

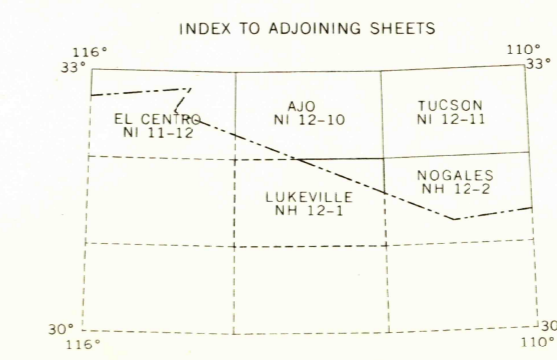
