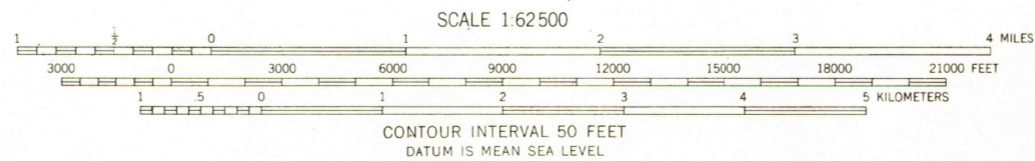
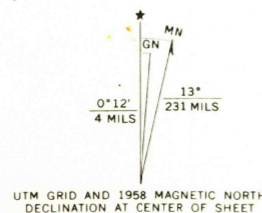


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Canelo Pass, Harshaw, Duquesne, and Lochiel
