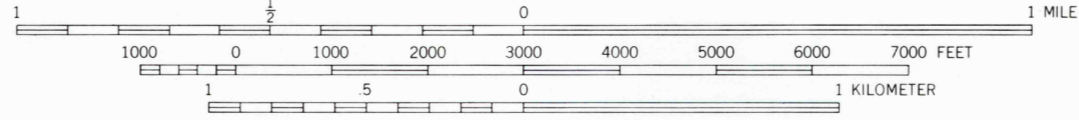
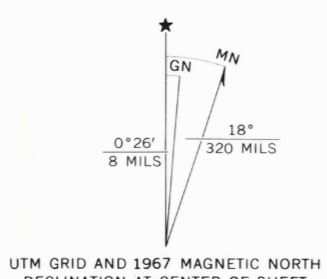
Polyconic projection, 1927 North American datum, 10,000-foot grids based on California coordinate system, zones 1 and 2
