

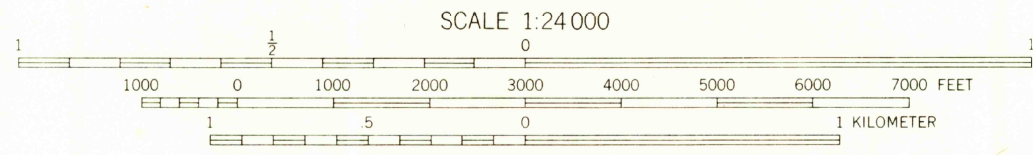
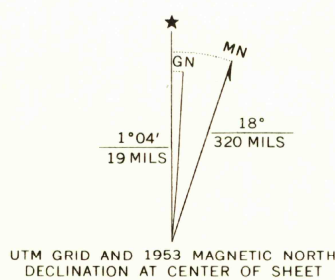

zone 10, shown in blue

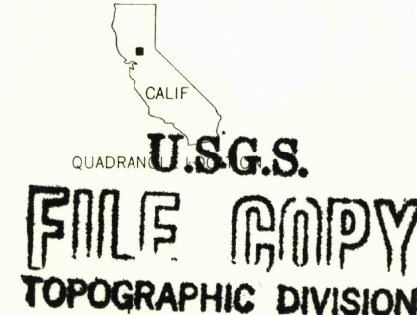
