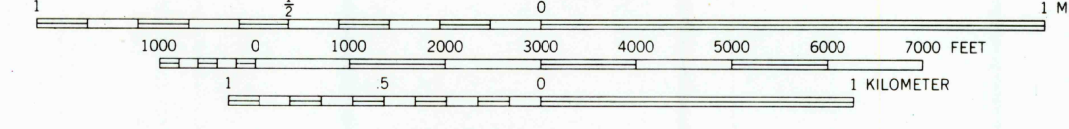
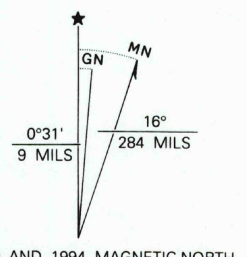
North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27). Projection and 10000-foot ticks: California Coordinate System, zone 2 (Lambert Conformal Conic)
