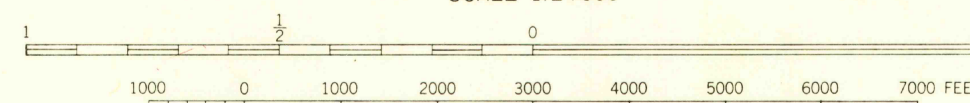
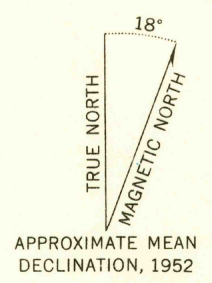

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

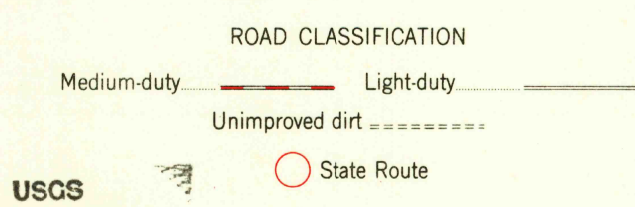
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
