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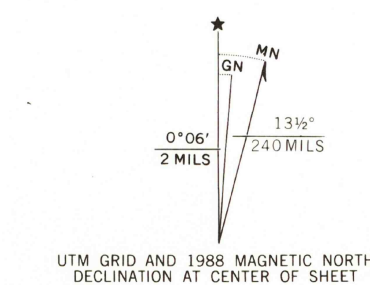

zone 11, shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum

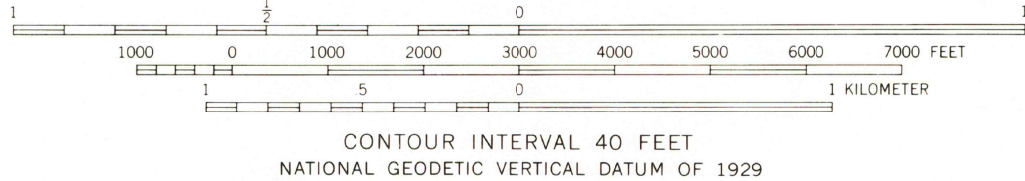

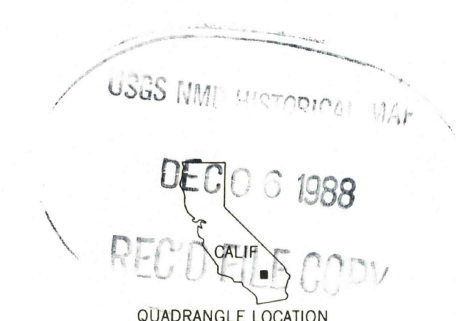
