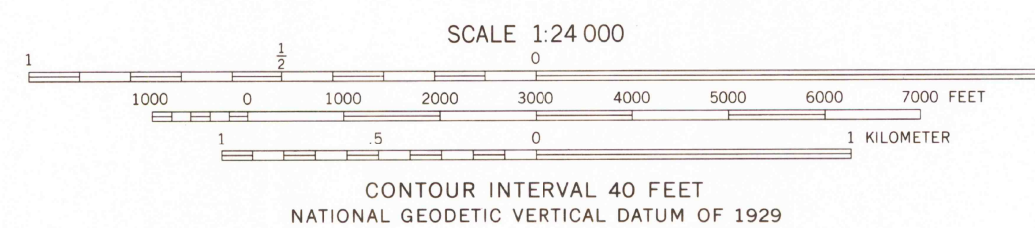

84 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

the National or State reservations shown on this map

No major culture or drainage changes observed

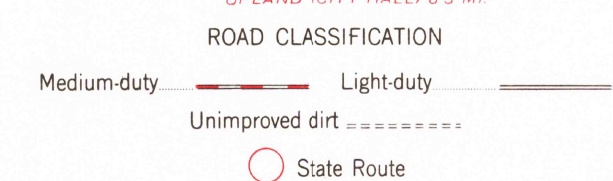
