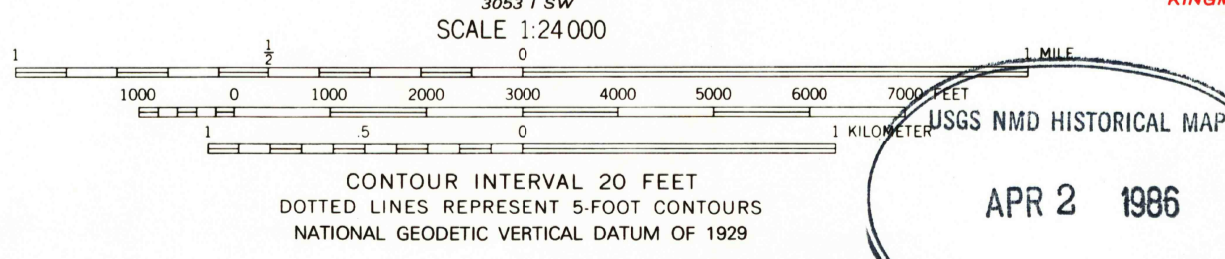
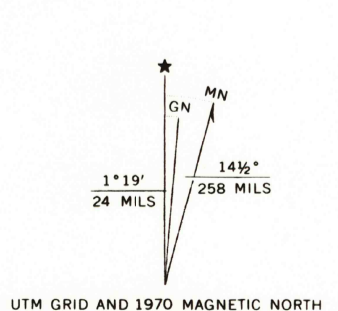

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters north and 74 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Where omitted land lines have not been established Indefinite boundaries of Fort Mojave Indian Reservation an old military reservation are in dispute  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
