Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grids based on California coordinate system, zones 1 and 2

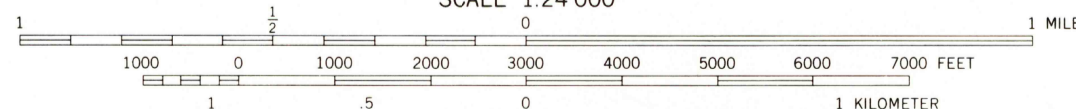
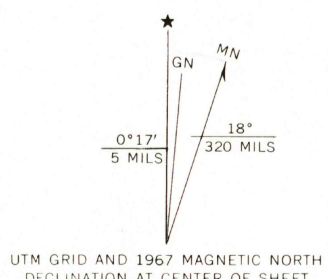
1,000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue
