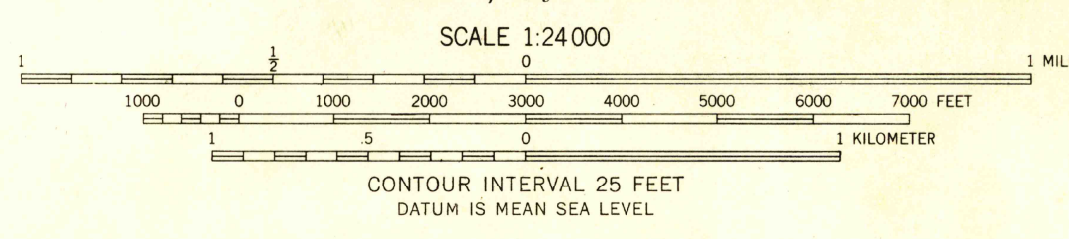


118° 48' CASTAIC 19 MI. LOS ANGELES (CITY HALL) 60 MI.
