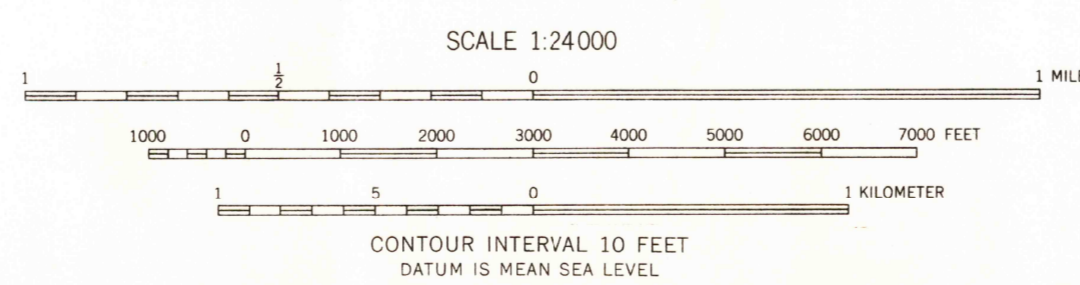
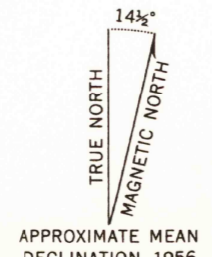


ELEVATION 235 FEET BELOW SEA LEVEL
