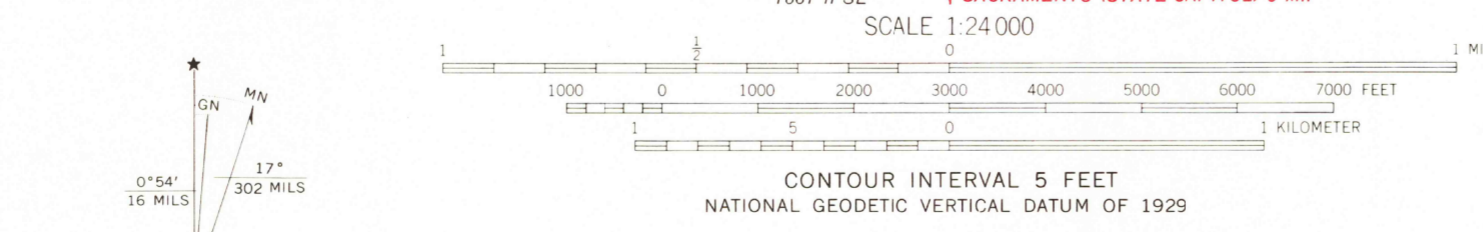

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 15 meters north and 92 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
