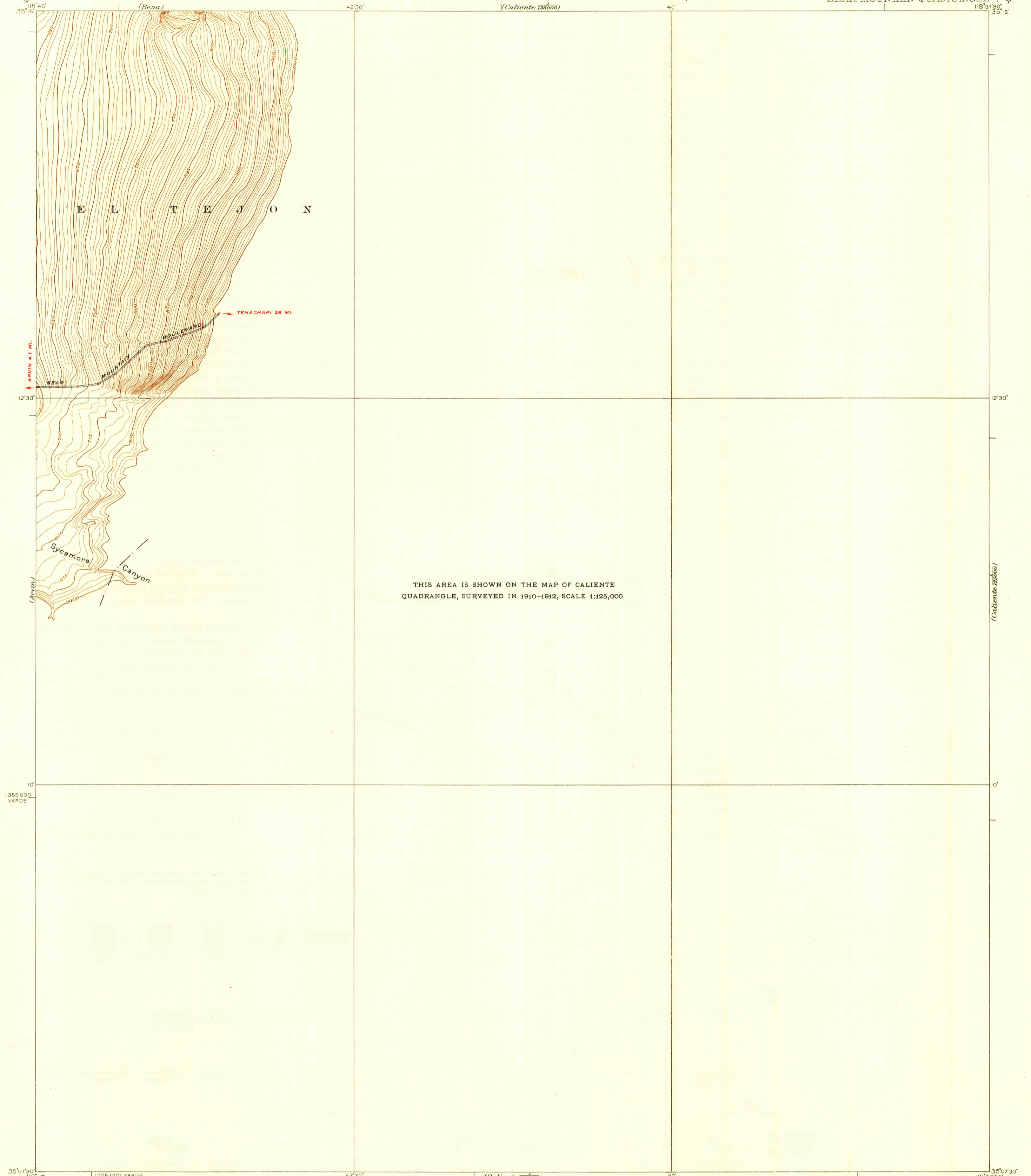

QUADRANGLE, SURVEYED IN 1910-1912, SCALE 1:125,000

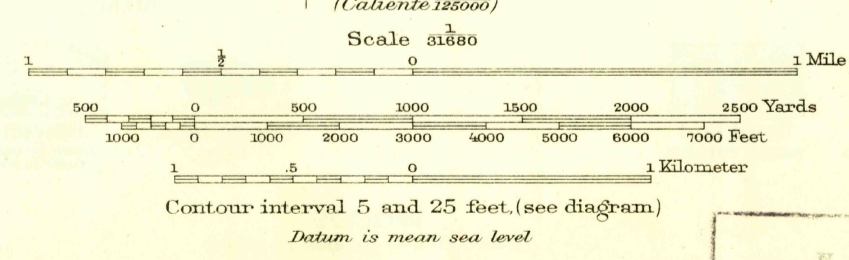
