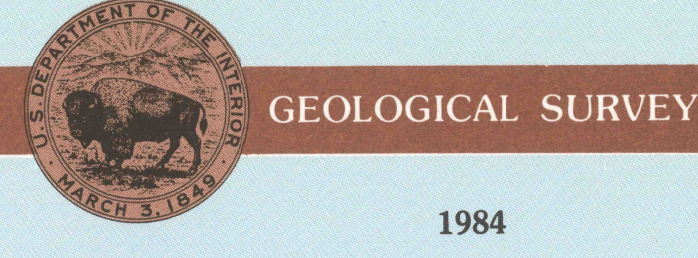




- 30 X 60 MINUTE QUADRANGLE SHOWING

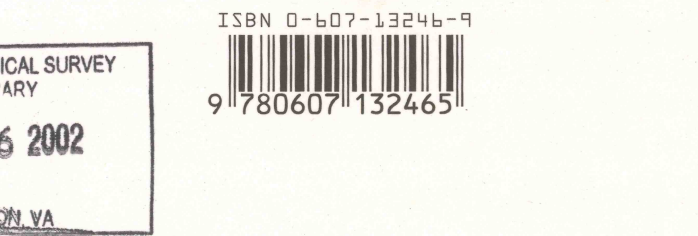
