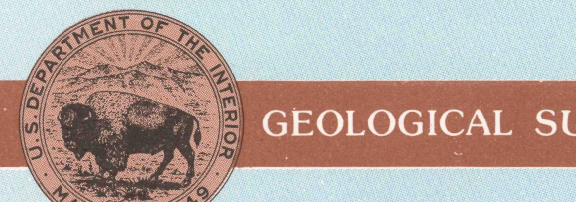

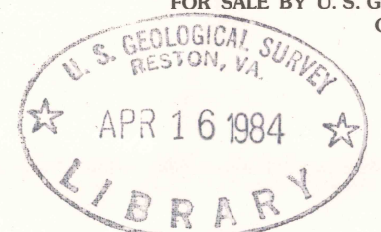
UTM grid convergence (GN) and 1962 magnetic declination (MN) at center of map
