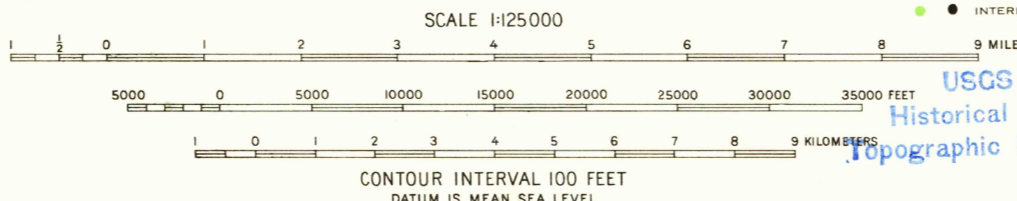


DIAGRAM OF TOWNSHIP
