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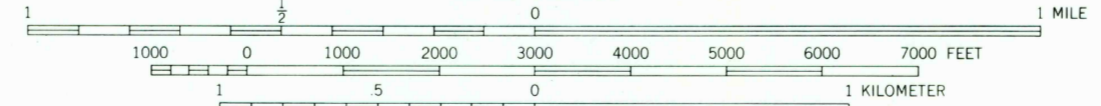
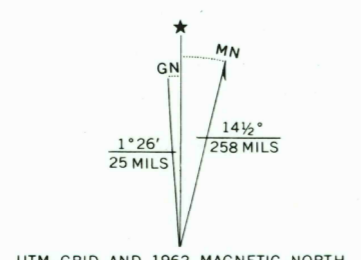

move the projection lines 7 meters north and  
52 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
