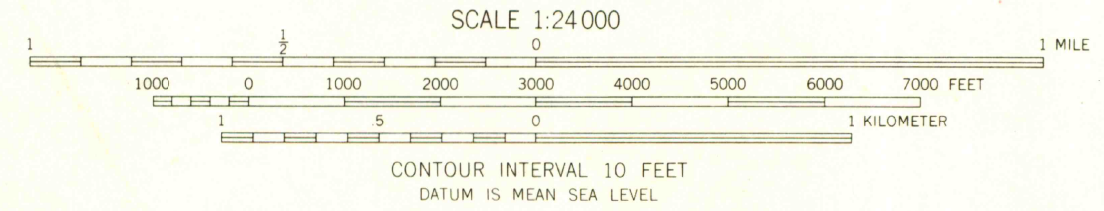

Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas

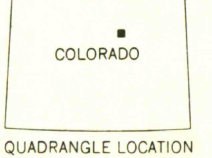
