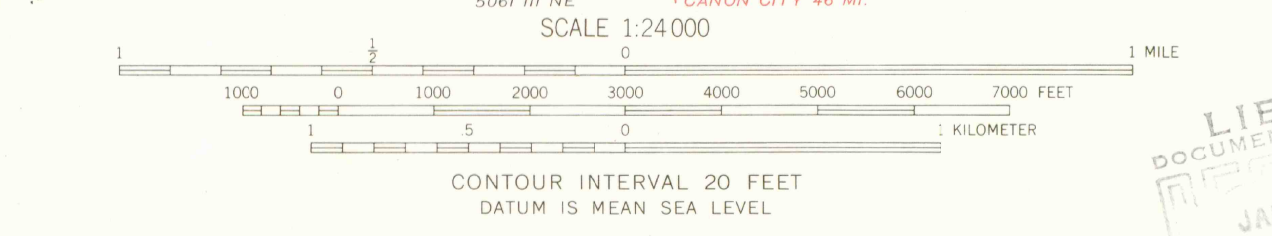


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Control by USGS and USC&GS  
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1947. Field checked 1948. Revised from aerial photographs taken 1960. Field checked 1961.  
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, central zone. 1000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue.  
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.

Revisions shown in purple compiled from aerial photographs taken 1969. This information not field checked.  
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas.
