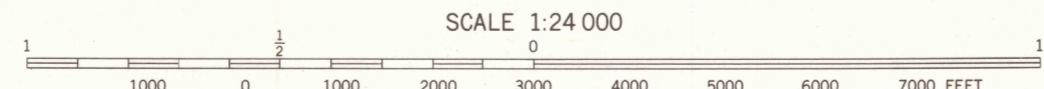
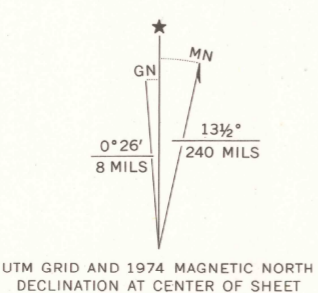
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum 10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, central and north zones

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

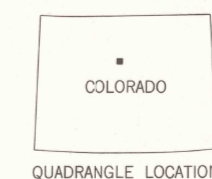
