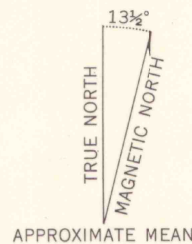

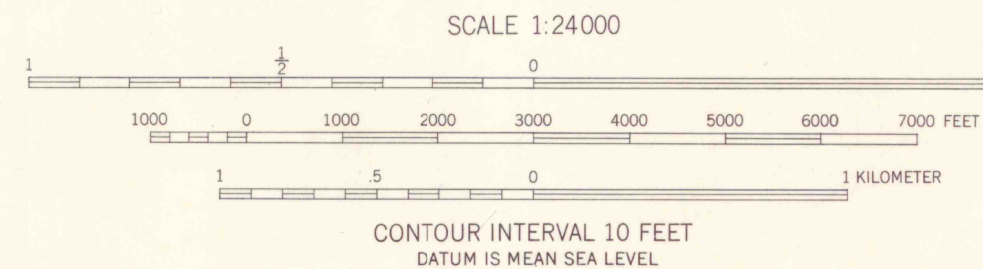

10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, north zone

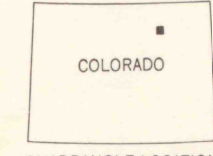
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
