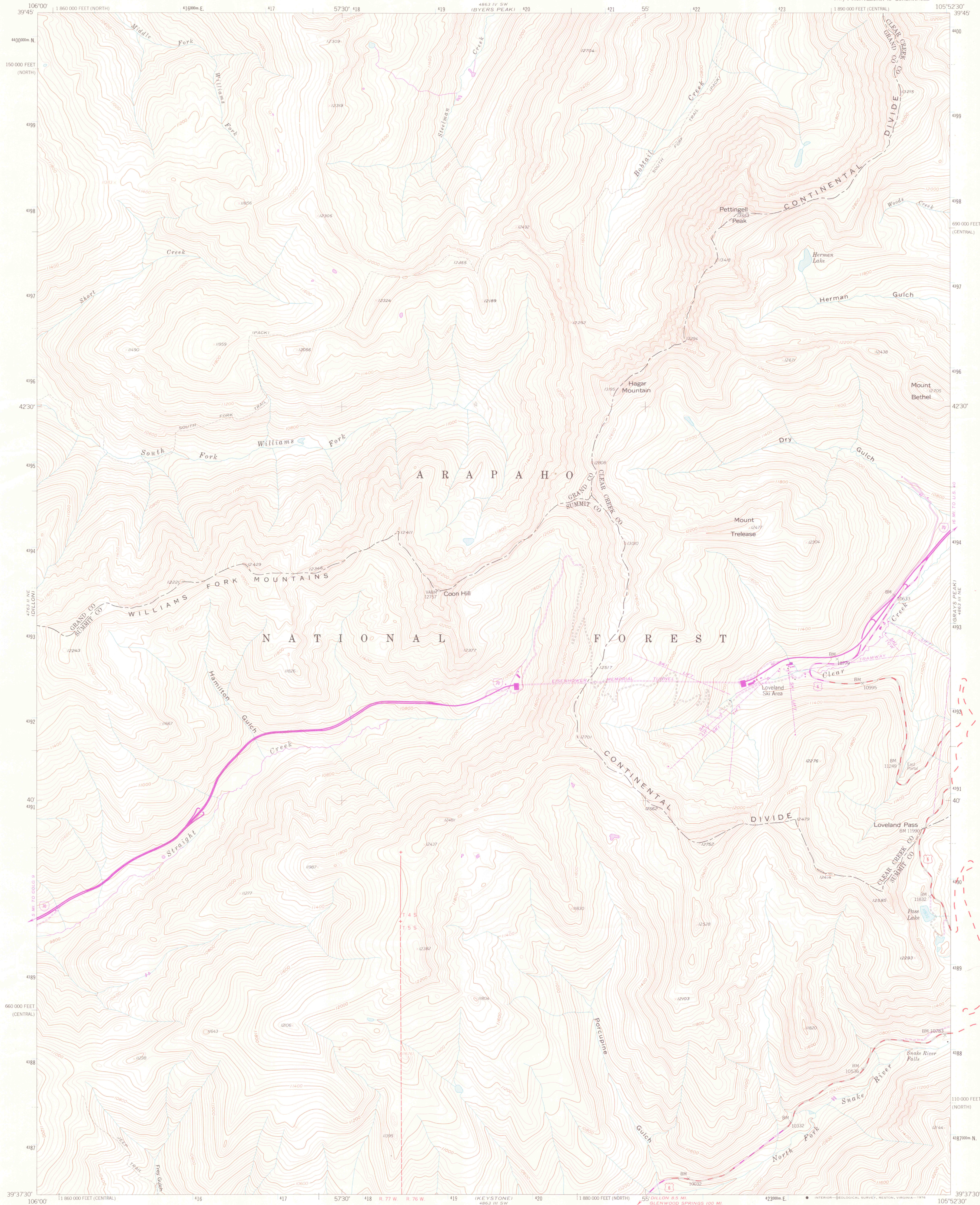

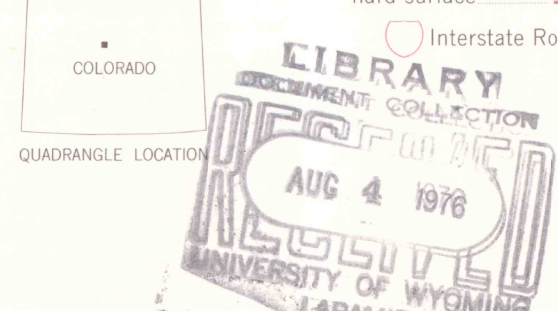
LOVELAND PASS QUADRANGLE
