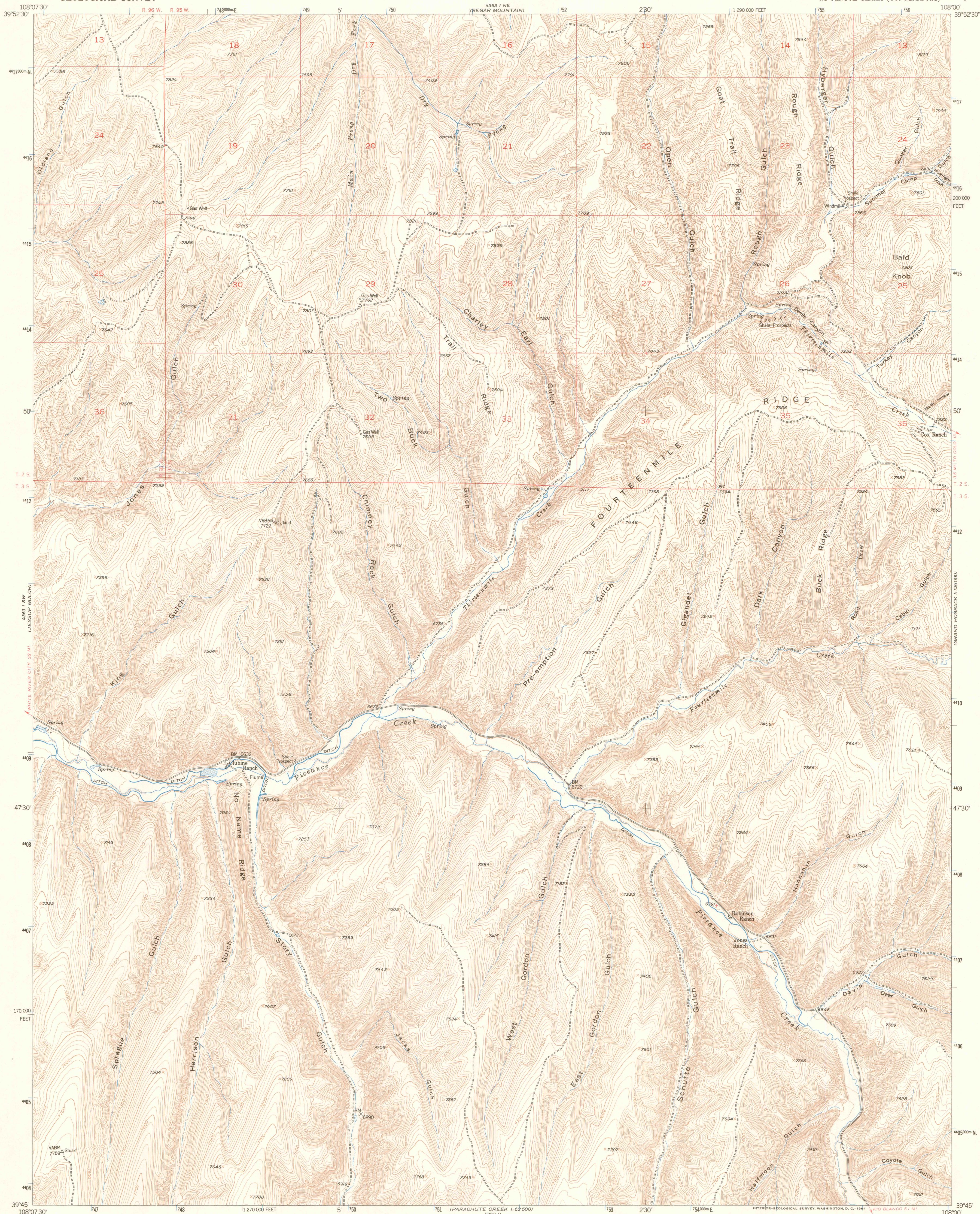

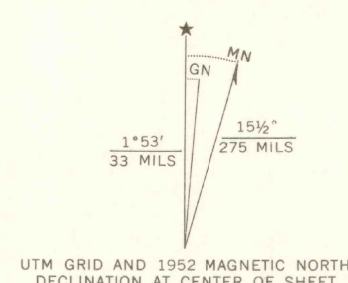

because of insufficient data. All recovered corners are shown

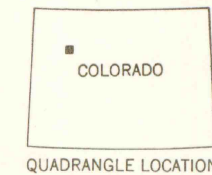
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
